Talking Transition: NYC in the Lead - Immigrant Integration November 2013 to December 2013

Talking Transition is an unprecedented community engagement initiative that pioneered the first "open" transition to a new citywide administration in New York City history. Talking Transition is an experiment in innovative government and grass-roots organizing that seeks to transform the typically insular, closed-door

process between Election Day and Inauguration into an opportunity for broad civic discourse. Following the 2013 mayoral election in New York City, Talking Transition brought thousands of New Yorkers together to join open conversations about the most pressing public policy issues, ideas, and questions that affect communities across the city. Over the course of more than two weeks, starting immediately after Election Day, Talking Transition created a forum for these discussions by hosting live events in a pop-up on Canal Street, open to the public 9AM to 9PM daily, and by bringing the conversations to neighborhoods across all five boroughs through mobile "tents" and a team of more than 100 canvassers speaking 19 different languages.

The event I produced showcased a multi-media history of immigration in New York City, with immigrant communities highlighting their achievements and discussing the issues facing immigrant populations today. After the history, a series of panelists discussed the current state of the city's immigrant integration efforts. The event closed with a number of musical performances.
